APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- a. All below questions must be answered completely and signed by the applicant and parent/guardian or social worker. Feel free to use extra pages as needed.
- b. Two letters of recommendation. One must be from your school guidance counselor, social worker, or DCF worker.
- c. An official school transcript of grades through March of the applicant's senior year, sealed by the school.
